Algae and bacteria typically start as an invisible film on the surfaces of pool walls and tile grout. Brushing these areas eliminates buildup before it becomes visible since shaded corners and spaces behind ladders receive limited circulation.

Chemical Testing and Adjustments

Water chemistry is checked at every visit. Our chemical testing measures pH levels along with chlorine, alkalinity, calcium hardness and occasionally stabilizer levels. Water balance and safety for swimmers is maintained through immediate adjustments during inspections.

Inconsistent testing of pool water chemistry allows minor imbalances to grow into unsolved issues which show as cloudy water and algae growth along with swimmer irritation. A professional keeps these fluctuations in check.

Filter Checks and Pressure observing
