The technician also performs cleaning or backwashing of your filter

depending on its type and current condition. Skimmer baskets are emptied and clear to ensure water is flowing properly.

4. Chemical Treatment and Balancing:

If necessary, the technician adjusts the pool water by adding appropriate chemicals to maintain proper water balance, shocks the pool if needed to eliminate algae and bacteria, and ensures proper chlorine levels for sanitation. Keeping your pool's chemical balance correct is essential in preventing algae growth in your pool, ensuring the water is safe for swimming. The pool technician near me will either add chlorine to disinfect the water, adjust the pH to prevent corrosion on surfaces, or add other chemicals to reach the standard water chemistry.

"Shocking" the pool is the process of adding a high dose of chlorine at once to eliminate any existing organic growth like algae or bacteria.
